



## Lake Supervisor Contact Information

Dear Lake Tyler Residents:

With the summer in full swing, we thought we would update you all with contact information for our Lake Supervisors regarding law enforcement or City ordinance requirements that apply. As you know, Lake Tyler and Lake Tyler East, often described as the "Crown Jewels" of East Texas, are owned and operated by the City of Tyler Water Utilities. Not only are they recreational and economic assets for the area, but they also serve as an integral part of the City of Tyler water system.

The City of Tyler Water Utilities provides two (2) Lake Supervisors to monitor the daily activities at Lake Tyler, Lake Tyler East and property immediately adjacent to the lakes. These Lake Supervisors are certified peace officers in the state of Texas and are responsible for insuring continued water quality of the lakes as well as enforcement of state laws and applicable City of Tyler ordinances both on the lakes and surrounding City owned property. The Lake Supervisors live at Lake Tyler and at least one of them are available twenty-four (24) hours a day.
